

Portrait Session reminder cards that reflect your portrait date and time will be given out this morning. Not certain what to wear? Lifetouch photographers say, "Be Yourself!" Dress can be classic, casual, sporty, fun....it's up to you. Here are some tips:

- Solid colors work best. Avoid busy patterns, they distract from your face.
- Avoid changing your hairstyle or cutting your hair right before your setting.
- If you are wearing special jewelry, mention to the photographer that you would like to have your jewelry featured in the portrait.
- Apply make-up as you normally would for an evening out. Remember: your eyes are the focal point in a portrait.
- If you wear glasses all the time, you'll want to have them in your portrait.
- Lifetouch offers portrait retouch that can soften lines, etc.

Portrait guides are available at the back of the sanctuary.
