Some of their most pressing needs are:

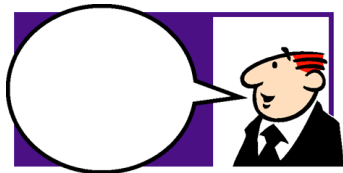
- SOCKS** – men & women's needed. **DISPOSABLE BABY DIAPERS** – any size
