

Church

New church directories are usually distributed in December or January. We will be changing this to coincide with the church's fiscal year which begins July 1.

Updates will be done in late July, early August with the new directories distributed in September. Also, by this application, the Leadership Team member listing can be included in the directory. July and August are also slower months for church activities so this will allow us adequate time to process and publish. Update forms will be included

in your bulletins beginning July 20 through August 10.

On Sunday August 17, there will be two offerings. Offering One will be our regular offering. Offering Two will be a "From the Heart" offering. During the first six months of 2014, our expenditures exceeded our giving by \$9,053. About one third of our giving units did not keep current on pledges resulting in



giving being \$5,500 less than planned. We also incurred extra repair and equipment expenses causing us to exceed the budget in the amount of \$3,553.

To bring our financials back to the level needed to pay our bills, we are urging each one to step out in faith and generously support the second offering on August 17. Our church has made commitments to outreach, church programs, staff, church property which we want to keep. Please take this seriously and make a generous contribution.
