Following is the financial update YTD through August, 2014.

The "From the Heart" offering of \$7,854 brought our budget income back in line. The giving response was overwhelming and is sincerely appreciated. Our expenses are a little over budget primarily because of more heat cost, more snow plowing cost and higher office machine repair cost than budgeted. Unless spring arrives about November 1, we probably won't be able to bring the fuel and snow plowing cost back in line. We negotiated a better cost on the new copy machine so that cost will be less for the months of September through December. This will help bring item closer to the budgeted amount for the year.
