

With Pastor David's retirement on November 20, the need to begin a pastoral search was the item of discussion at the October 13, Leadership Team meeting. Led by Torin Eickler, Northern Indiana District Executive, the Leadership Team learned the process required to begin the search. His opening words were "It's okay! Take a deep breath! It's okay! You can do this!" Those words had a calming effect for the team. Torin explained the entire search process followed by a time for questions. This article will outline the first part of the process and future articles will follow the advancement of the process. The first step will be forming a search committee. The committee will consist of 5-7 individuals chosen by the Leadership Team. This team will work directly with Torin. The second step is the selection of an interim pastor focused on transition. Torin explained the particulars of this step saying that trained transitional pastors specialize in helping congregations during the transition from one pastor to another. The Leadership Team voted to hire a transitional minister and to start the search immediately.
