

Honduran Church: David presented the request from Honduran Church (10 persons at present) to use Lincolnshire on Tuesdays at 7:00 P.M. and Sundays at 4:00 P.M. They offered to help in ways we might suggest. Craig, Lori & Marilyn will meet soon with their representatives for initial conversation.

Review/Observations regarding Youth Presentation Feb. 25: Each person was asked to respond. Responses were:

1. **Music:** How does pastor "bridge" preferences for traditional and contemporary?

2. Scripture: Well-presented for some: too difficult for others.

3. **Predictability of service**: Some persons like pattern; others desire spontaneity.

4. Interactive sermons: Youth asked for more.

5. Video: Are effective. How much of service should be on screen?

6. Bulletins: Different opinions. Needed or not needed?

7. Where's the energy? Energy or lack of it can be "felt" upon entry.

8. Flow of service: Contemplative & quiet or building to energetic response?

9. Qualities needed: flexibility, receptivity, and patience.

10. **How much do we change?** Do we prize community enough to give up our preferences? What's the price of not changing?

11. David commented on our "phenomenal caregiving. It's who we are." (Results of discussion were summarized by Craig.)

Sabbatical: Kevin & Sharri have requested a sabbatical during the month of June. Plans are in place for their responsibilities to be handled during their absence.

Financial Report: Current balance at the end of March was -1,039. A Quarterly Report was distributed showing expenses, percentages, and balances remaining in various accounts.
