

Stewardship reports that June's contributions totaled \$9,544. We had expenses of \$15,931 which leaves us with a negative balance of \$6,387. We paid quarterly payments for Outreach and pension that were due plus an equipment repair of \$2,000.

On a year-to-date basis, contributions totaled \$71,211 and expenses totaled \$72,673 leaving a negative balance of \$1,462.
