**Proposal to Host Honduran Church** 

Outreach and Caring Ministry Team and Pastor Bibbee recently met with Pastor Cervantes, his wife Norma and daughter Kimberly Sosa to discuss their request on behalf of their congregation to use Lincolnshire as a meeting place. Leadership Team affirmed the idea and voted May 26<sup>th</sup> to bring the proposal to the congregation.

The proposal was explained by Marv Loutsenhizer including...

- Meeting twice a week (Tuesdays at 7:00 and Sundays at • 4:00)
- Willingness to help with work projects.
- Emphasis on ministry, especially to young people and congregational growth. Their current attendance is approximately 20.

Noted during discussion:

- Once approved, Honduran congregation will begin using • Lincolnshire as soon as possible. There is no "end time" as this is a "growing experience" for us and them.
- No one from Lincolnshire needs to be present when they • meet. The intention is to be as least restrictive as possible.
- Enthusiasm and genuineness of the group was mentioned.
- No tax issues are involved. •
