

Leadership Team Minutes of July 28, 2016

Present: Lori Linn, Bob & Marty Kaylor, Marilyn Drudge, Terri Woods, Heather Grady, Dave & Evelyn Bickel, Jan Williams, Sara Loutsenhizer, Linda Robbins, Jan Ward, Paula Sosenheimer, Judy Steckly, Carolyn Egolf, Margaret Pletcher, and Sharon McKay.

Treasurer's Report: Marilyn reported a negative balance of (- \$1,462) for June. So far in July expenses exceed revenue by \$1,200. The 2016 Budget to Expenses Report for Second Quarter shows a shortage of (- \$4,433) when pledges are compared to budget. There is concern for future income losses furthering the deficit.

Kitchen Stove - Options were presented. Jan Ward moved that South Bend S6oDD 60" Gas Range be purchased for \$700, with \$615 from the Welborn memorial fund. Lori will give \$85, and additional costs for hookup, etc. will be drawn from Westerfield memorial. Terri seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Bylaws/Responsibilities: CDC had earlier asked Ministry Teams to review responsibilities as listed in Bylaws. Lori had also given a form to each Ministry Team to clarify what they actually do - a working document.

Jan Ward reviewed the list from Outreach & Caring and clarification was given regarding Camp Mack. Camp Mack Festival and fund-raising events involving the church kitchen will be under Outreach & Caring, while Camp representative, registrations, publicity, etc. come under Christian Ed. Several things on Outreach & Caring's list merge with office responsibilities. It was suggested that plaques be placed near items donated with memorial money. Outreach & Caring will see to this.

Christian Education: Judy Steckly distributed information regarding C. Ed. responsibilities, as well as plans for fall. Teachers are needed for youth. Heather will check the possibility of an intern from IPFW. **Kick-off Sunday is September4.**

Katie & Lori set up video for Sunday, July 31. Youth may feel overloaded, as AV process involves both creating the presentation and emergency help on Sundays if needed. There are persons willing to learn.

Bylaws (Cont.): Suggestion is to split Constitution and Bylaws, so responsibilities of Ministry Teams are a separate document. To do this requires congregational approval. More time and information is needed for a decision. Item is tabled till Aug. 25.

Stewardship: Bob reiterated the potential loss of pledges, suggesting budget will need to be cut or special offering taken. **Worship & Music:** Starting date for choir is indefinite.

Have your children embarrassed you to death by repeating an expletive from your mouth in a place which made it stand out all the more... like church? Have the wrong words come from your mouth at the wrong time like in the presence of the wrong people and the room goes silent? **Awkward** moments make you want to dig a hole and jump in. Today's text from Luke has its share of **awkward** moments. Sometimes following Jesus seems **awkward** if we're not in tune with what Jesus is doing.
